Colour Clues

"If you every doubted the importance of colour to our livesjust imagine a world of only black and white."

Colours of both the frame and mat have a profound effect on the visual presentation of the artwork. Ideally - artwork should be framed for the enhancement of the art itself.

When selecting a suitable colour scheme you need to know:

- Where will the item be displayed?
- ♦ What is the predominant colour in the room where the picture will hang? (I.e. carpets, walls, window treatments etc.)
- What is the style of furniture and decor?
- Will the picture hang over a piece of furniture?

Next look closely at the picture, look for clues and try to duplicate the feel and intent of the artist's work.

- Note the dominant, neutral and accent colours & their proportions.
- ◆ Study the overall size, texture and proportions of the design (e.g. are the lines delicate or bold are they round or straight?)
- ◆ Look at the colour is it opaque, transparent, pale or bright?

Once you know the answer to these questions you are then able to decide which frame and mat option best suits the artwork.
